



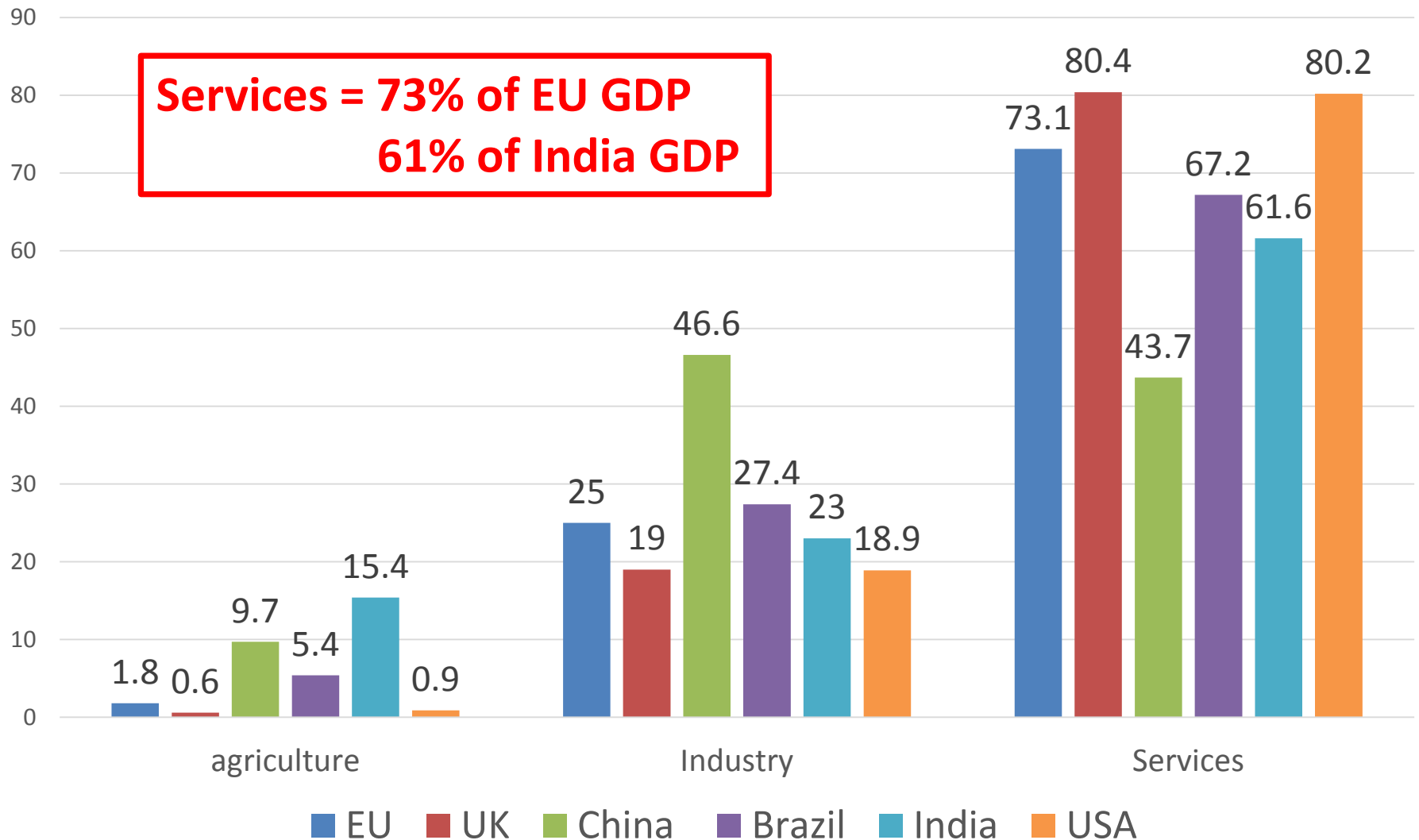

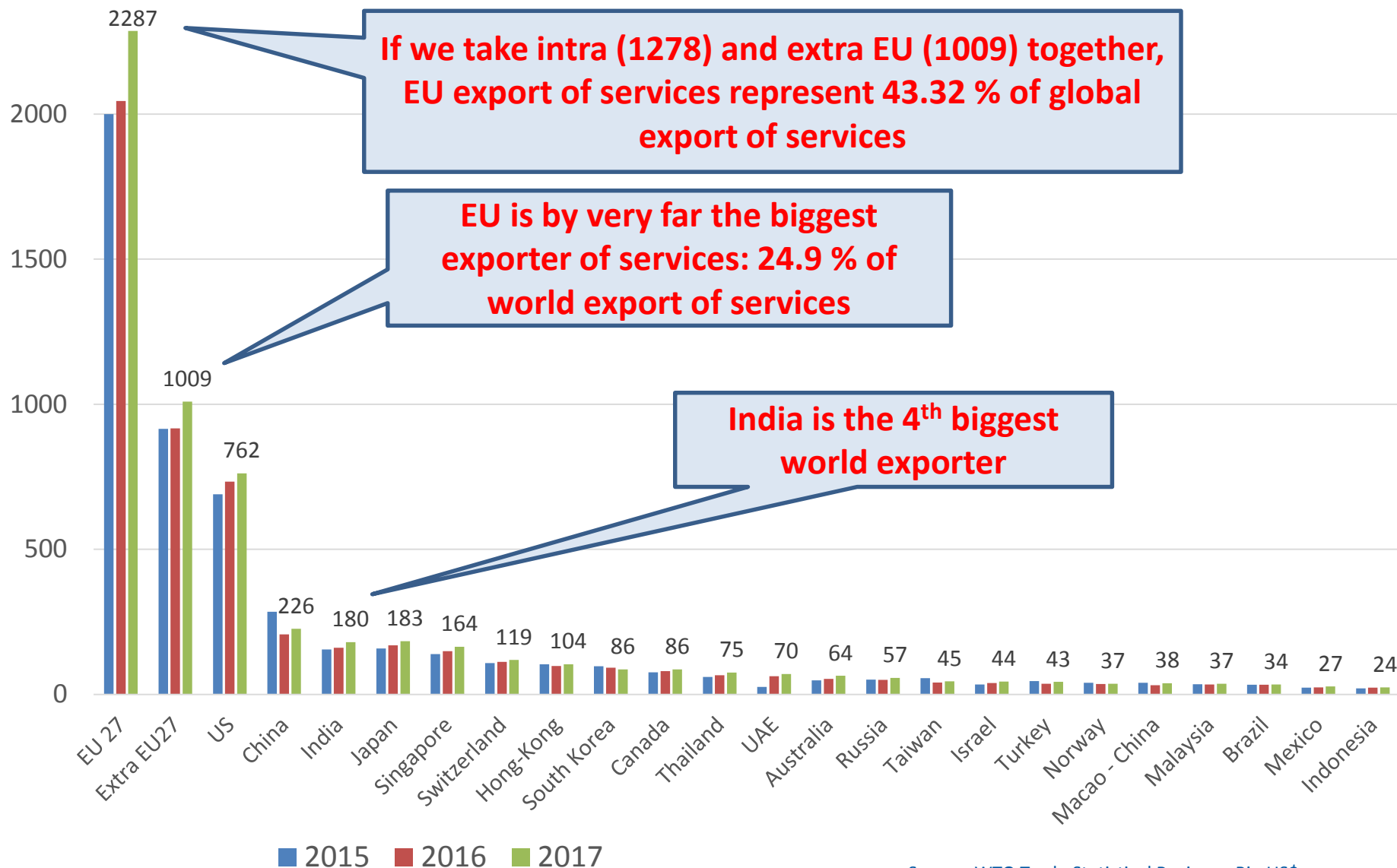

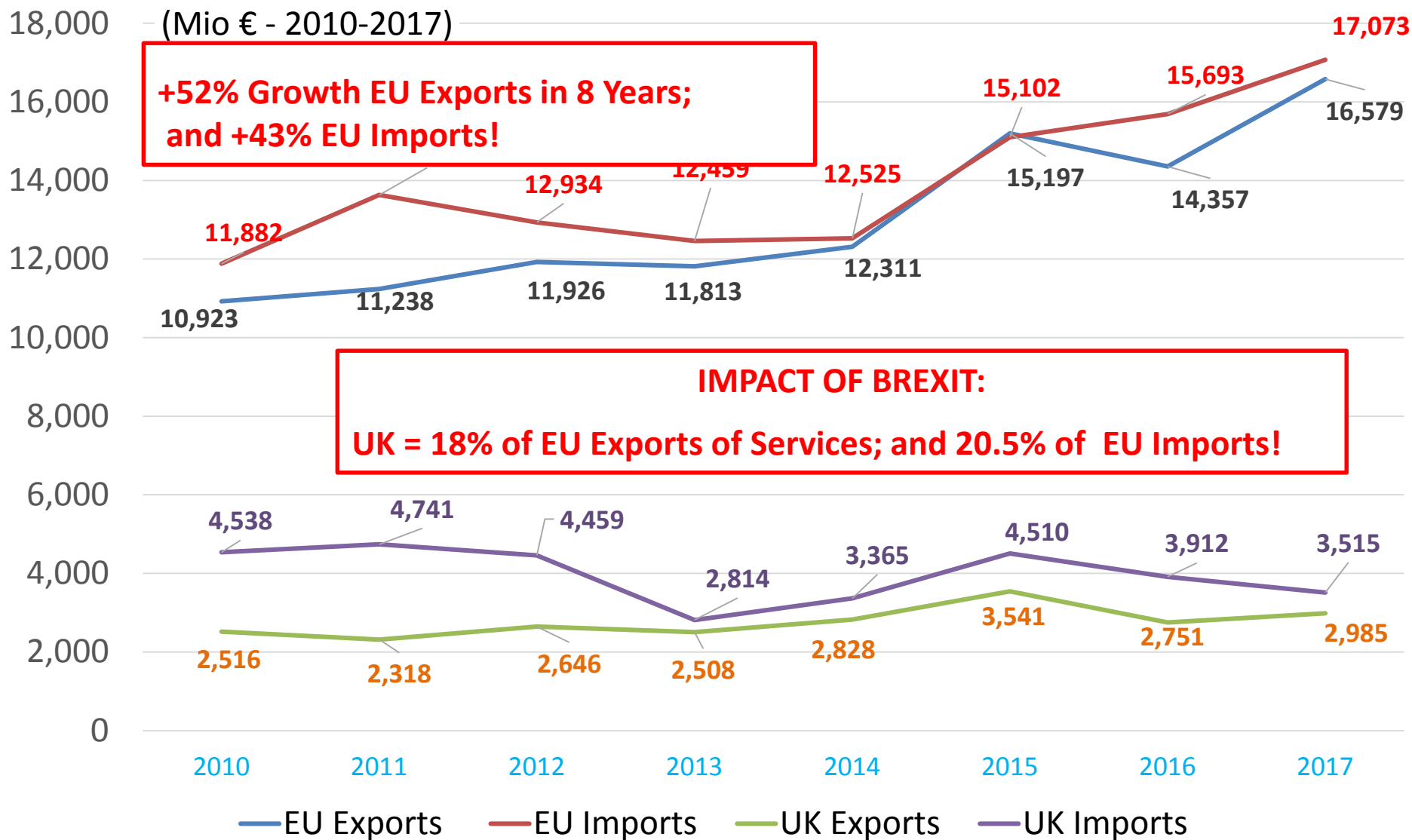
EU Economy per sectors – GDP - 2017



THE EU IS BY FAR THE WORLD BIGGEST EXPORTER OF TRADE IN SERVICES

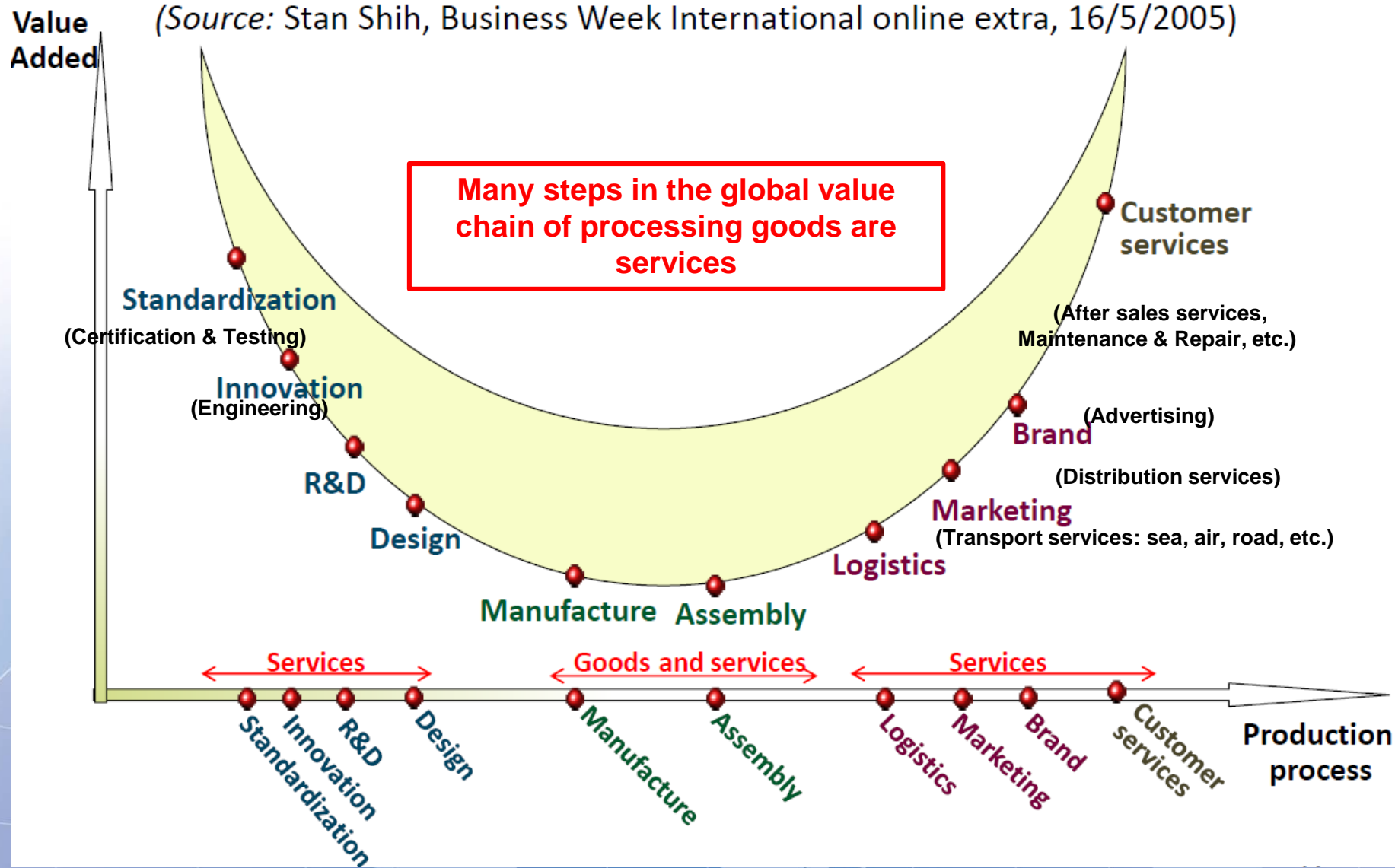


EU and UK Trade in Services with India

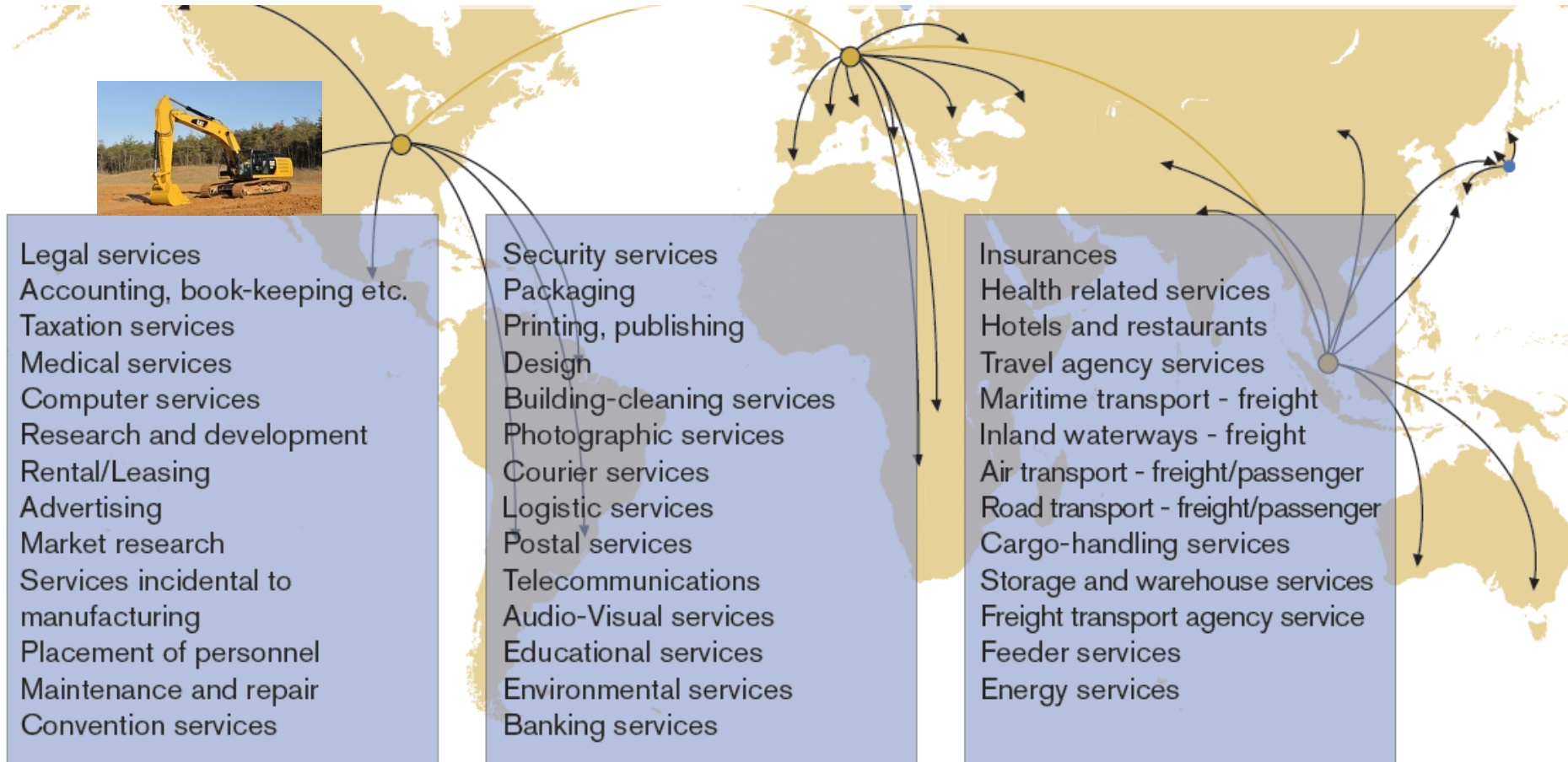

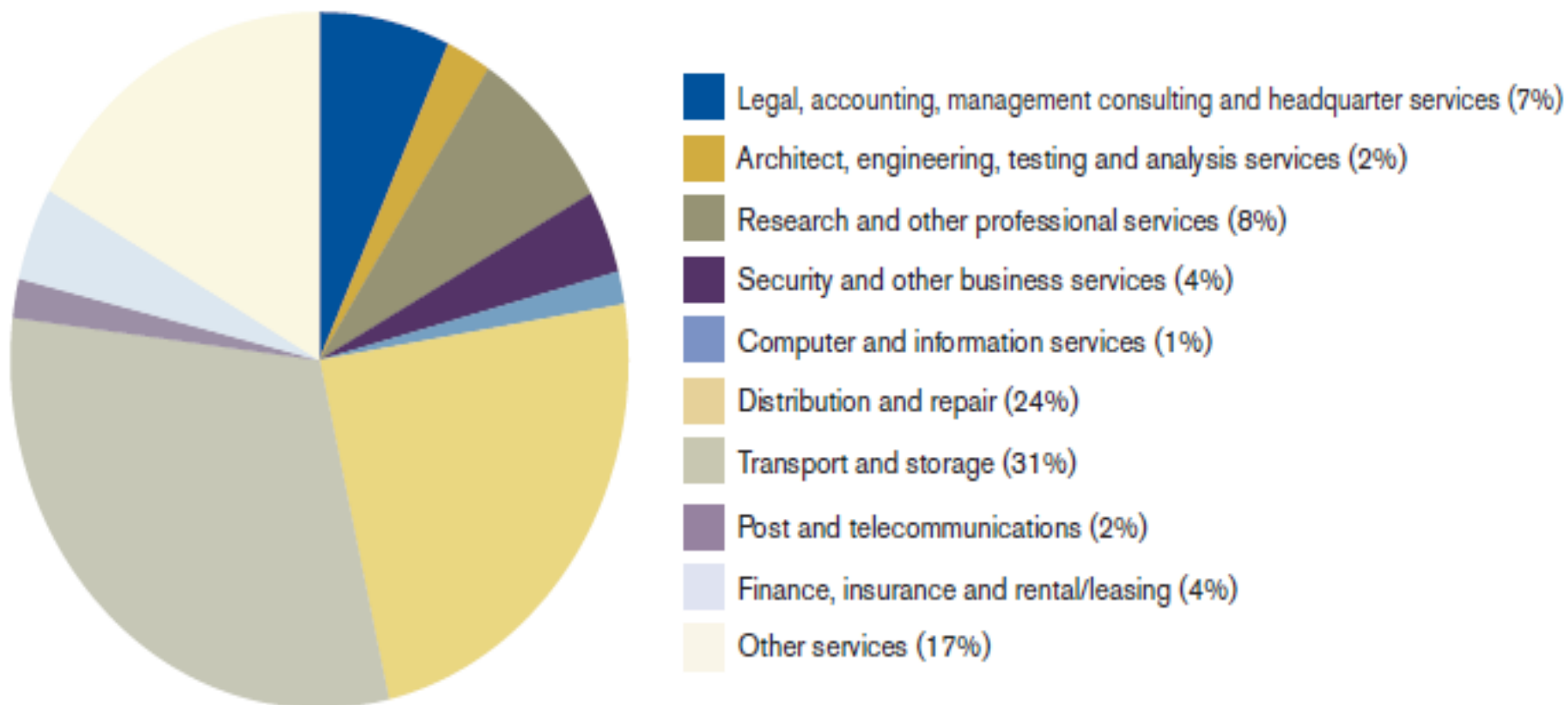
Picture 2: Examples of services needed at different parts of the supply chain

Embedded Services in the products → Essential elements of creation of value added and benefits for the production and export of goods !



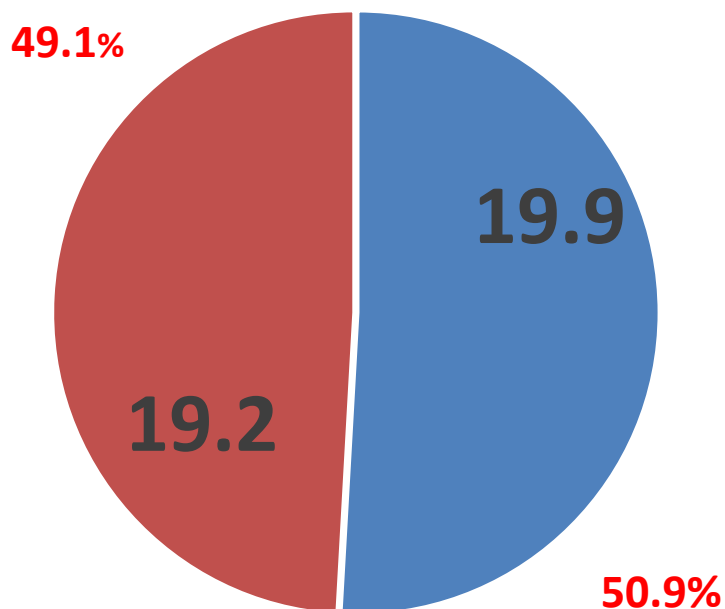
Figure 1: Services input in the food sector (Sweden, 2008)

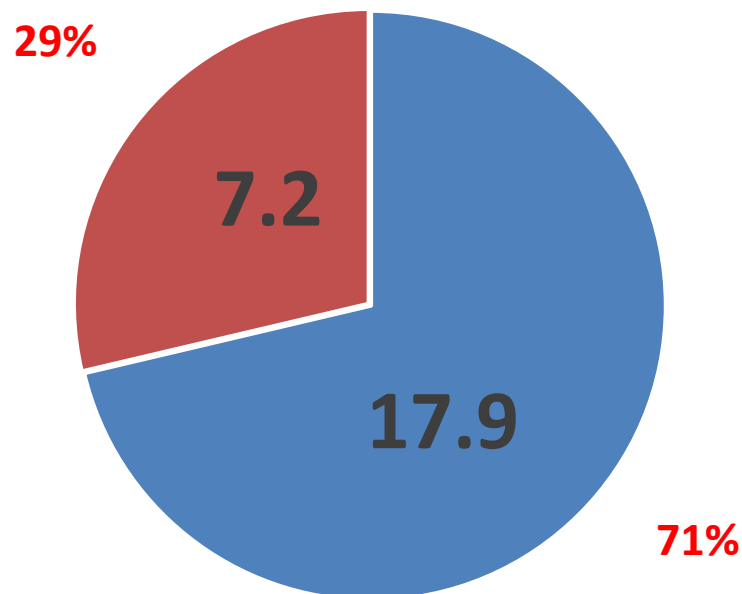
Share of Services value added in EU & India Goods Exports

EU27 = 39.1%



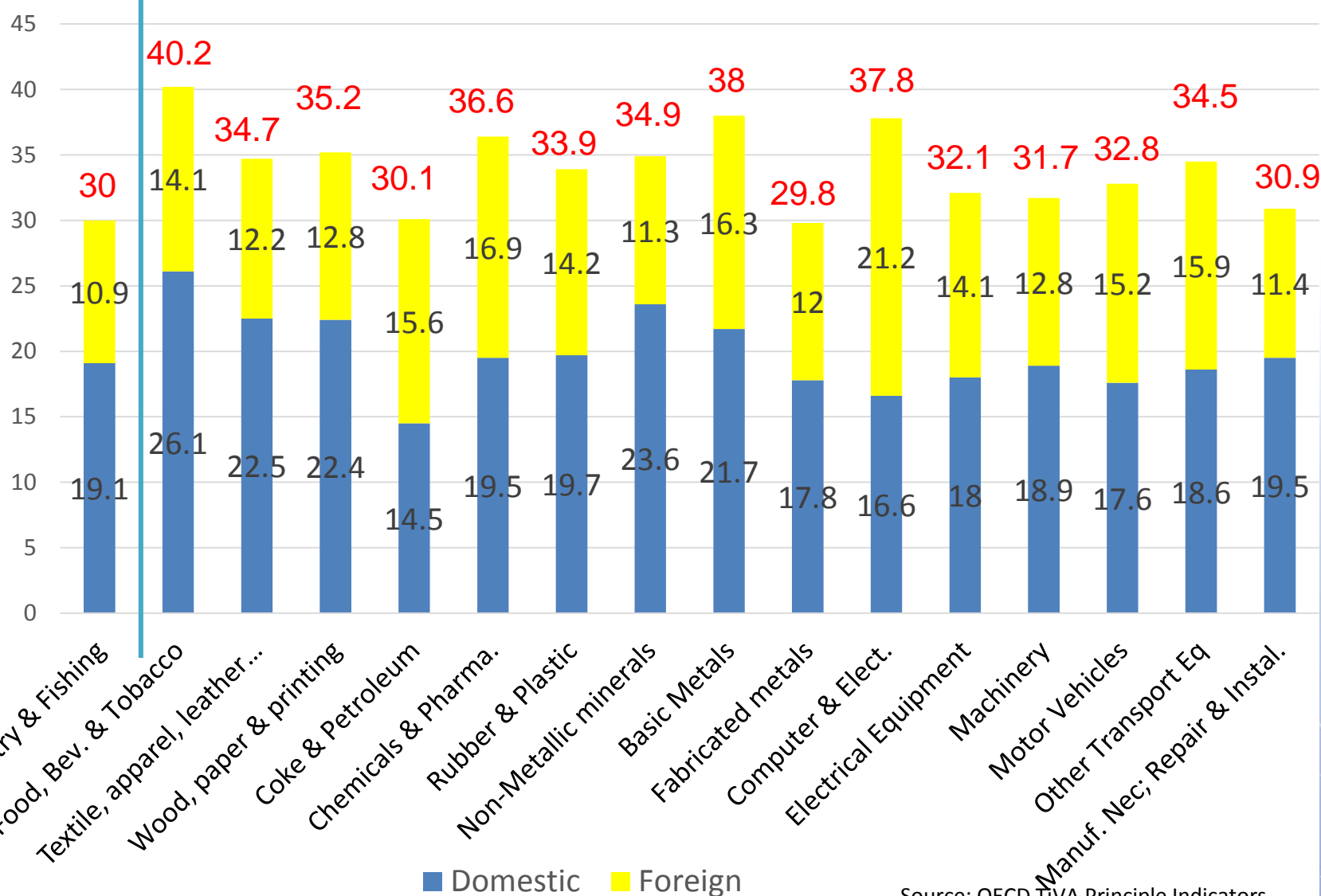
■ Domestic Services

India = 25.1%

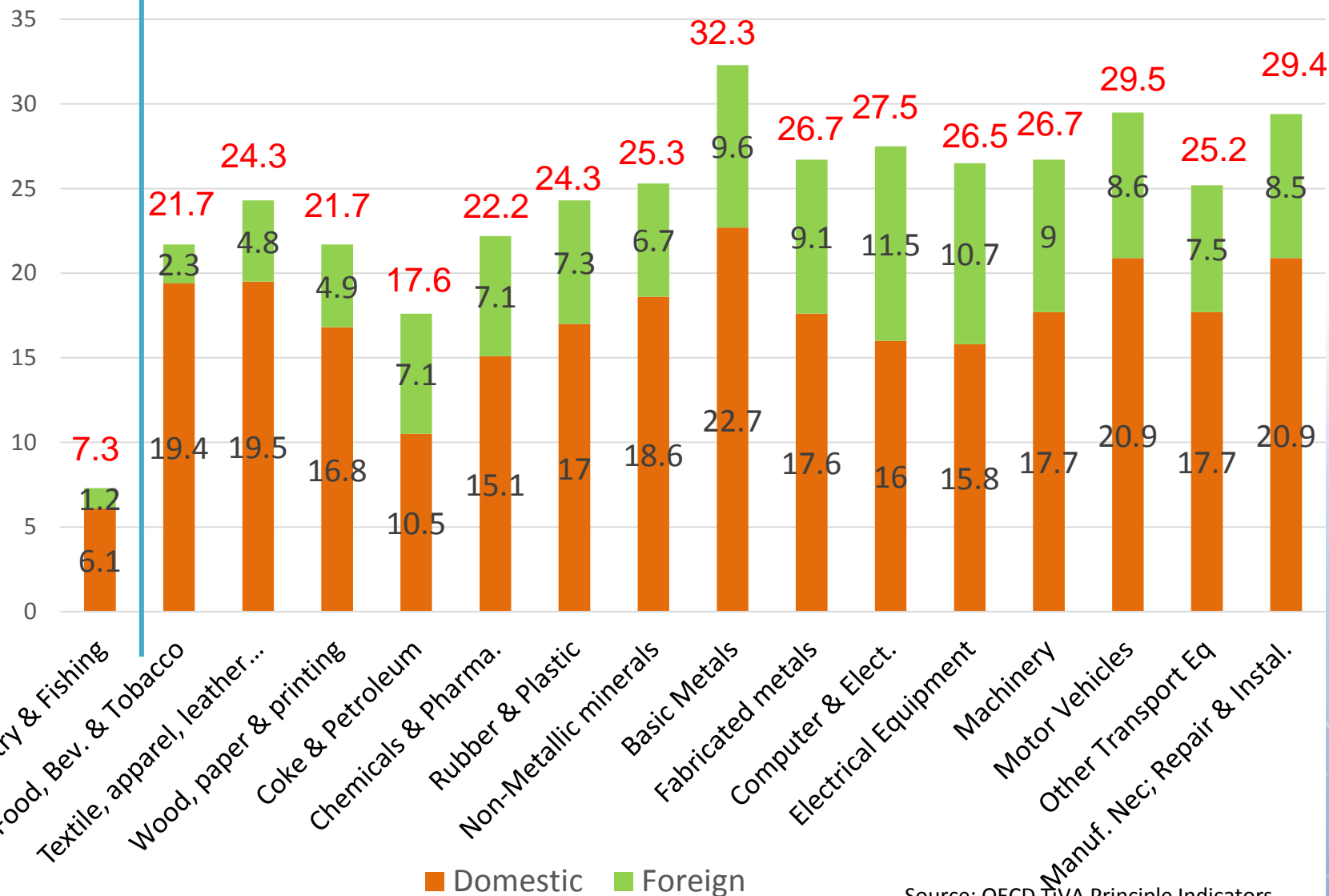

INDIA Services Value Added across industries – 2016 - %

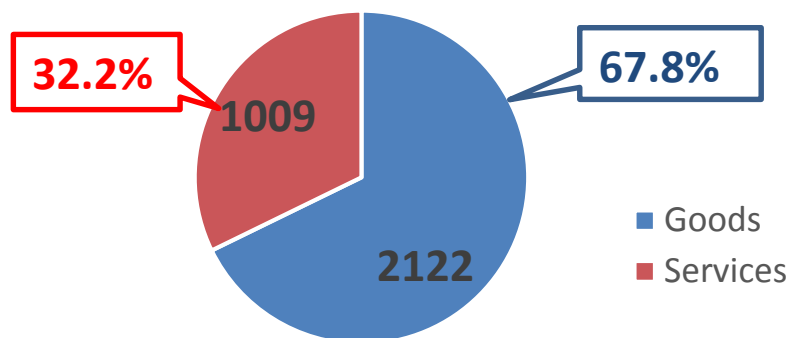


IMPORTANCE OF TRADE IN SERVICES for EU & India

If we use the trade in value-added (TiVA) indicators,

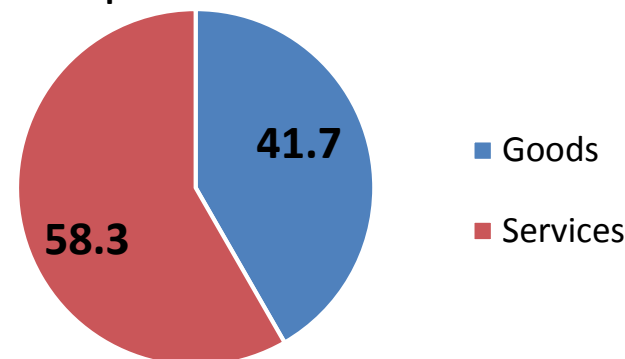
58,3% of total EU VA Exports are Services

EU Exports in BOP - 2017 – Bio US\$ & %

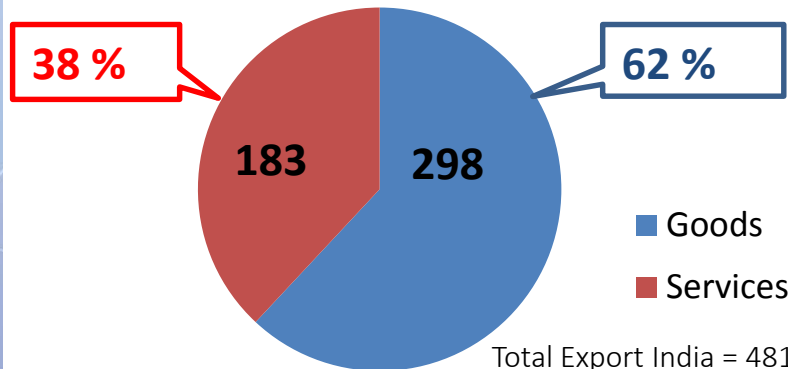


Total Export EU = 3131Bio

EU Exports in TiVA - 2011 - %

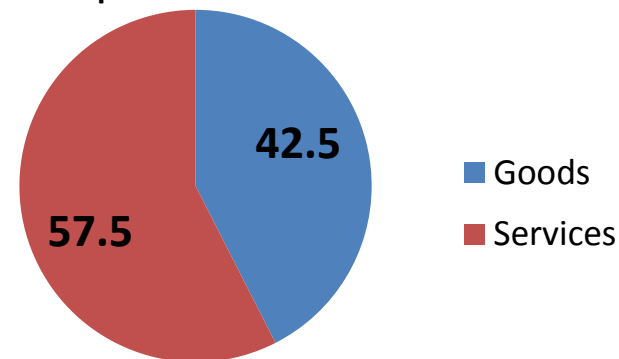


India Exports in BoP - 2017 – Bio US\$ & %

57.5% of total India VA Exports are Services

Negotiations under “Services chapters” of Trade Agreements cover the whole economy!

- **Mode 1 = Cross border trade in services**, but in fact it covers any activities. Critical for the Digital transformation of the economy! All Machine-to-Machine communications, All international activities of “Internet of Things” “IoT”, “Industry 4.0”, “3D Printing” do require cross border data flows!
➔ Need clear banning of local server and local presence requirement to be able to take profit of economy of scale!
- **Mode 3 = Commercial presence abroad**, covers not only services companies, but all sectors (agriculture, aquaculture, fisheries, mining and quarrying, all manufacturing sectors, incl. “**Manufacture of food products and beverages**”).
- **Mode 4 = Temporary Movement of natural persons**, include mobility of consultants, lawyers and auditors, but also the **technicians and engineers of manufacturing** companies who travel for maintenance and repair & after sales “services”!
